Headline	Watermark Global gets positive results from pilot water treatment plants

LONDON (Thomson Financial) - Watermark Global Plc., said results from its two water treatment pilot plants in South Africa demonstrate that the output from these plants easily exceeds the minimum quality stipulated by the authorities and that a management agreement has been concluded with the mining companies Harmony, DRD and Mintails in the Western Basin. The company, formerly known as Microfuzze International Plc and which is now focused on developing a specialised water treatment and management business, said it expects to complete additional agreements with the mining houses in the Central, Eastern and Far Western basins soon. Negotiations to supply treated water to third parties in the Rustenburg area are also proceeding, the company said. In an AGM statement, Watermark added it still has a healthy cash balance from the 2.5 million pounds raised last July, which will enable it to continue with pilot plant trials, engineering design and costing.
